ABA is a scientific approach for teaching meaningful skills and addressing socially significant problem behaviors. It is based on the principles of behaviorism, which have demonstrated their effectiveness with neurotypical and classified populations for almost 100 years. Working in the ABA field can be the path to a rewarding, lifelong career of helping others.

Various ABA providers will be on hand to talk to you about their companies and conduct interviews. While ABA has many applications, most positions currently available entail supporting and teaching children with autism. If you haven't already received ABA training or achieved RBT or RBAI certification, most companies will provide training and can discuss the process with you at the event. Please dress professionally and bring your resume, as the regional job market is quite competitive.

We encourage students, RBTs and RBAIs to attend the full conference, which includes keynote speaker Dr. Francesca Degli Espinosa and presentations on current topics such as teaching complex language to children with autism, and promoting diversity and cultural competence within ABA.
